The Action Plan also highlights the fact that Bill C-28, *Fighting Internet ad Wireless Spam Act*, has received Royal Assent (but has not yet come into force), and that Bill C-12, *Safeguarding Canadian's Personal Information Act*, which includes data breach notification requirements for organizations, is awaiting second reading (both IC lead).

Bruce spoke to PS yesterday, and these changes are being made to their document.
